VCCA Seeks Data for Family Court Review

In preparation for discussions with staff from the Supreme Court and the General Assembly, the VCCA needs each Clerk to compile data related to the number of deputy clerks assigned to chancery cases. The VCCA believes the number of clerks required to staff the new family courts in Virginia as recently released by the Supreme Court does not properly reflect the actual number of circuit court deputy clerks who perform duties related to chancery case processing. Each circuit court clerk is requested to provide data to John T. Frey, Clerk of the Circuit Court in Fairfax County, who will be compiling statewide data and presenting this data to the General Assembly's subcommittee on the Family Court. Clerks should report this information to John Frey as soon as possible.
